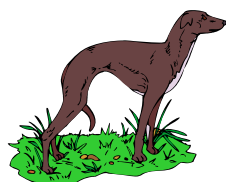

NEWS OF THE PARK

As many of you know who ride by the Headworks construction project, between Tunnel 7 and Tunnel 8, it is almost complete. This was a 3 year construction project in which our horses got used to giant skip loaders, earth movers, guys welding and banging on pipes, and in general the noise and activity of a very large construction project.

The huge water storage tank is almost completely covered with dirt. When the roof is covered, there is a plan to landscape it with native plants. Also, there will be a long promised hiking and equestrian trail created around the perimeter of the Headworks mound.

We commend the Supervisors of this project for their sensitivity to the equestrian traffic as this all took place within a few feet of the main trail itself. For the most part, they were alert to any possible trouble an equestrian might be having with their horse, and were courteous about stopping activity for a moment until the rider and horse passed by.

There will be another giant tank built, starting in a few months. However, it's construction will be away from the main trail, and closer to the Forest Lawn Mortuary. It should have no impact on equestrians on the trail. (continued on next page)



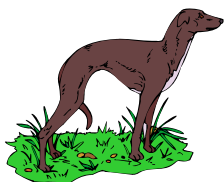
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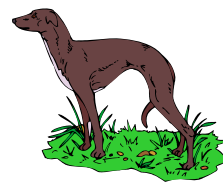

Martinez Arena removal of excess sand took place from Thursday, April 9th to April 16, 2015. The Maintenance people have had an excellent attitude about necessary adjustments to make Martinez as good as it can be. They have spent a lot of money to make Martinez a good arena for public use.

At the north entrance to Tunnel 7 (many people think of it as the first tunnel since it is the first one equestrians ride through after crossing the Mariposa Bridge heading into the Park) there had been a ruptured pipe belonging to Cal Trans. The pipe first broke in March and flooded the entrance to the tunnel.

A quick fix was done, however, recently it broke again. CalTrans has said that the pipe is about 2 miles long, and has to be drained of existing water prior to fixing it.

I had received many complaints that the pipe is still leaking as there is a muddy puddle at the north side. However, it is not leaking, the water was cut off at the time of the second break. What riders were seeing was water draining into the puddle, not leaking per se. The pipe is empty and CalTrans has repaired it. Hopefully they will work with Rec and Parks to find a solution to its position in proximity to the tunnel so that we do not have more breakage.

Due to the drought, riders will notice dying bushes and trees throughout the park. Even in the picnic areas where trees are watered with reclaimed water, they are not doing well.

It turns out the according to the forestry people, the trees don't like reclaimed water. It's too salty. The reclaimed water does well for lawns and golf courses as the growing grass carries the salt upwards where it is then mowed.

The trees are a sad and unexpected victim to the drought.

There is considerable controversy about opening a stretch of road on Mt. Hollywood. That area has been closed for nearly 20 years. Due to the flood of tourists wanting to get closer to the Hollywood sign, there are a lot of problems for homeowners in Beachwood Canyon, and now vehicle traffic on what was a closed road.

There are a lot of Park users who are very upset at this. I will give more information about this as some kind of solution is to be reached.

The repair of woodcrete fencing is continuing throughout the Park. The woodcrete is quite expensive and there was a long backlog and wait for it to arrive.

Now it's here and work has begun to replace damaged fencing.
