• As most of you already know, Burbank City Council passed an Ordinance for the Mariposa Bridge stating that no bikes will be allowed on the Bridge, not ridden, not carried or pushed. It is a complete ban on bikes on that bridge.

Soon, there will be a bike only bridge constructed off of Bob Hope Drive that will cross the LA River and end on Forest Lawn Drive.

Although the Ordinance has been passed, it takes 30 days after the Ordinance is officially adopted and goes into effect. The Ordinance took effect on Friday, March 25. Burbank will post signage referring to the bike ban Ordinance which then can be enforced by Burbank P.D.




